Ping JIANG FAIA is the founder and design principal of EID Architecture, a leading international practice for architecture and urbanism based in Shanghai and Hong Kong. Ping Jiang has worked extensively in the United States, Europe, and Asia through his career. His work aims to address the ever-changing urban conditions in China and beyond, confronting the challenges of complex urban realities and environmental

issues with an impressive portfolio of projects across typologies and scales. He has been awarded numerous international awards, including multiple AIA Design Awards, The Plan Award, Architecture Review Future Award, and World Architecture Festival Award. AD 100 named Mr. Jiang as one of the 100 most influential designers working in China. His studio won 2022 AIA International Firm Award. •



Xiangming HUANG Honorary FAIA is the Chief Architect and Board member of TIANHUA Group. His fields of expertise are urban development and renewal, cultural architecture, residential architecture, office and commercial development, and comprehensive development. More than 30 years of experience in architectural design has bestowed him with profound understanding and keen insight on cities and architecture.

He was named the French Chevalier of Arts and Literature in 2021.



Philip F. YUAN Honorary FAIA is a professor at the College of Architecture and Urban Planning at Tongji University and Editor-in-Chief of Architectural Intelligence journal. He served as Thomas Jefferson professor at University of Virginia, visiting professor at MIT, and Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology. Yuan co-founded Digital FUTURES Association and served as a council member of UIA Professional Prac-

tice Commission. Yuan is a pioneer of architectural intelligence and robotic fabrication, integrates technological innovation with design and culture, environment and ethics to advance human-machine collaboration. He received notable awards, including 2022 AIA Open International | Architecture Honor Award, 2022 Dezeen Award Best Civic Building, and 2020 ACA-DIA Innovative Academic Program Award of Excellence.
